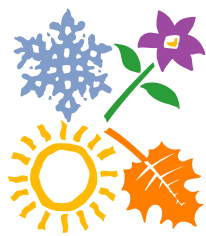

Coming up this Sunday...

This Sunday we will share in the Lord's Supper. The communion meditation will be "**The Less than Magnificent Seven**," from **Mark 7:14-23** and **Hebrews 12:1-3**. This meditation is an introduction to our Lenten Sermon and Small Group Series that starts February 19 on "**Avoiding Rocks that Can Shipwreck Your Life**" or "**Gilligan's Island and the Seven Deadly Sins**." This Sunday we will look at where the list came from and why these seven – sloth, anger, pride, greed, gluttony, lust, and envy – are so deadly. But the main theme is the hope we are given at the Lord's Table that makes us able to look at the hard stuff.

NEW! Stewardship Update

NEW! We are already way behind our needed giving to both the operating budget and the mortgage fund at this point in the year. As of the end of January we received **\$42,828 for the operating fund against a needed amount of \$61,923. This is a shortfall of \$19,095 or 31%.** We have received **\$13,747 for the mortgage fund against a needed amount of \$19,667 for a shortfall of \$5,920 or 30%.**

NEW! Our **per-capita apportionment** or "cost-per-member" that we pay to Presbytery for 2012 is **\$27.70 for each person in your family who is actually a member of the congregation.** Those who are able to assist in this way may place a check in the offering marked "per-capita."

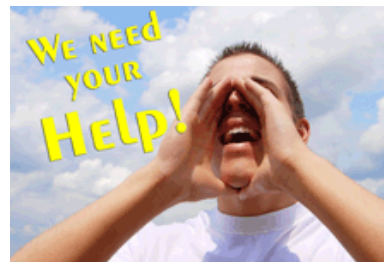
